Sir,

In continuation to this Ministry's letter of intent of even number dated 12.1.2001 and with reference to your letter No. P/Min/SMC/235/2001, dated 16.1.2001 on the above noted subject, I am directed to convey the approval of the Central Govt. to the establishment of a new medical college in the name & style of "Subharati Medical College" at Meerut by Subharati KKB Charitable Trust, Meerut with annual intake of 100 (Hundred) students with prospective effect i.e. from the academic year 2000-2001 under Section 10 A of IMC Act as amended in 1993.

2. The above permission to establish a new medical college and admission of students is initially for a period of one year and will be renewed on yearly basis subject to verification of annual targets set out in the project report and revalidation of performance bank guarantee for the required amount. This process of renewal of permission will continue till such time the establishment of medical college and expansion of hospital facilities are completed as per norms of Medical Council of India. The college shall not admit more than one batch of students against this letter of permission. The college shall also apply to the MCI for renewal of permission well intime. While applying for such renewal the achievements in terms of infrastructure, staff & equipment as spelt out in the Time Bound Action Plan & as required by MCI norms must be clearly spelt out. The next batch of students shall not be admitted unless renewal of permission is granted by the Central Govt.
